



## Our Educational Courses

Hello again INHWE Members! We take part in a number of projects which we believe can be used by a large proportion of our membership base because they are usually interprofessional in nature and focus on transversal skills. As many members may not always be up to speed with which projects we are working on, or indeed ones that we have already completed, we thought it might be useful to revisit the tools we have created that are applicable to you as educators or the students you teach:

**VRHealthLeaders** – We produced an [E-Learning for Educators](#) course that aims to provide educators and trainers with all the tools they need to implement our virtual reality leadership course. Additionally, the [online course](#) aims to provide healthcare professionals and students with a simulated experience to teach them leadership capabilities which can easily be transferred to practice.

**StoryAidEU** – We created an [interactive lecture](#) that provides educators with an example of a storytelling workshop that uses some of our fundamental tools that help to humanise healthcare through the use of storytelling. Additionally, the [online course](#) can be used by healthcare students and practitioners for autonomous learning or as an asynchronous part of a blended learning course.

**Digi4Health** – We produced a [toolkit](#) which contains a repository of all the training materials that educators and trainers can use to teach students about the on-going health services transformation. Additionally, an [e-learning platform](#) can be used by your students to learn autonomously in their own time.

**SAFEMEDIC** – We created an [online course](#) for healthcare practitioners and students to help improve workplace safety by increasing their skills and competences in dealing with difficult situations.

**DIGI4ME** – We produced an [E-Learning for Educators](#) course which aims to provide healthcare educators and trainers with all the tools they need to implement that DIGI4ME curriculum in their institution.
