Cyprus to Host ATBH XII 2027, the World's Leading Conference on Interprofessional Education and Collaborative Practice

[Interprofessional.Global](#), the World Confederation for Interprofessional Practice and Education, has confirmed that Cyprus will host the 12th edition of the International Conference on Interprofessional Education and Collaborative Practice - All Together Better Health (ATBH XII) in June 2027. The conference will be co-hosted by the [International Network for Health Workforce Education \(INHWE\)](#) and the [European University Cyprus \(EUC\)](#) and will take place in Nicosia.

ATBH is the leading global gathering of health and social care educators, practitioners, researchers, policy makers and service users committed to advancing interprofessional education and collaborative practice. The 2027 conference is expected to welcome more than 500 delegates from around the world. The conference will feature plenary sessions, interactive workshops, student challenges and poster presentations.

Director of INHWE, David Smith, commented: "we are delighted that Cyprus will host ATBH 2027. Both INHWE and EUC have a strong commitment to advancing education, collaboration and innovation in health and social care which makes us ideal hosts for this global event." This was echoed by Professor Elizabeth Johnson, Dean of the School of Medicine at European University Cyprus, added: "European University Cyprus is honoured to co-host ATBH 2027. EUC has extensive experience in health profession education and international collaboration with a strong track record in transnational initiatives. This conference will provide an exceptional platform for educators, students and professionals to share evidence, build partnerships and promote interprofessional learning that will lead to better health for global communities."

This will be the first time ATBH is hosted in Southern Europe, underscoring the region's growing contribution to healthcare innovation and international collaboration. The Advisory Board of the Southern European Interprofessional Education Network (SE-IPEN), who represent IPE stakeholders in the region, stated: "Hosting ATBH 2027 in Cyprus offers a unique opportunity to showcase Southern Europe's commitment to interprofessional education and collaborative practice while strengthening global partnerships. We are thrilled to be part of this global exchange that improves teamwork, empathy and equity in health care."



Professor Marion Huber, Chair of the Interprofessional.Global Board commented, "Hosting the 2027 All Together Better Health XII in Cyprus recognises the growing leadership and innovation emerging from Southern Europe in interprofessional education and collaborative practice. ATBH has long been a catalyst for global connection and collaborative learning, and convening in Nicosia will further strengthen our collaborative commitment to teamwork, equity, and people-centred care. ATBH XII will connect people, evidence, and practice to drive meaningful and sustainable improvements across health and social care systems worldwide."
