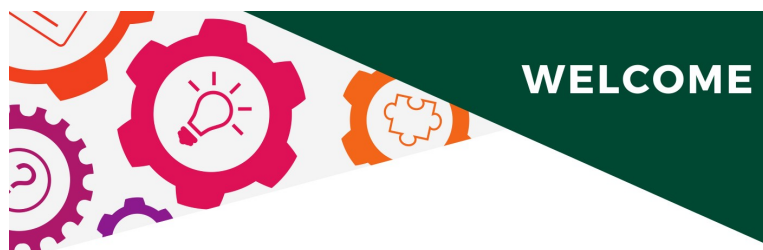




## Learning Together for Clinical Excellence
