Similarly, intergenerational education is essential within the framework of IPE to harness the strengths and insights of healthcare professionals across different age groups. By promoting collaboration and knowledge sharing between younger and older generations of healthcare providers, intergenerational education enriches the learning experiences of all involved and contributes to a more dynamic and innovative healthcare workforce. Integrating intercultural and intergenerational education into IPE not only enhances the competencies and capabilities of healthcare professionals but also promotes a more inclusive and responsive healthcare system. By fostering these competences, collaboration among healthcare professionals from diverse backgrounds and generations, healthcare organizations can better meet the needs of an increasingly complex healthcare environment.
